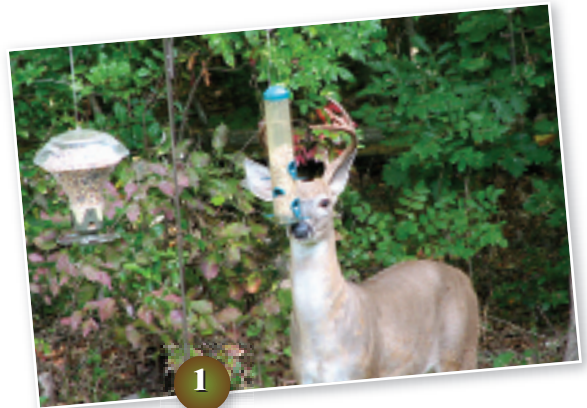

BUCK EYEING ▲ George Parry of Ruckersville found this bold buck looking into the food supply in his backyard.



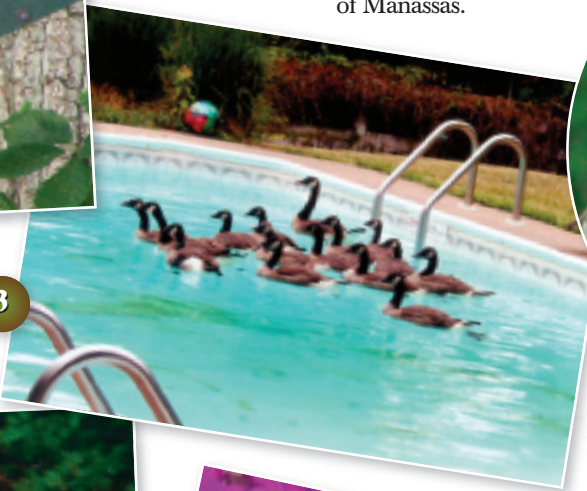
