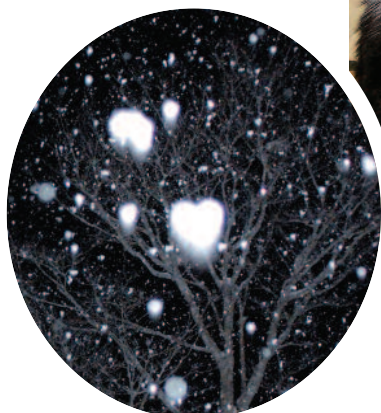
► **PUURRFECT HEART**

Nicole Clontz got a special Valentine's Day surprise in 2014 when a snowfall photo revealed a heart formation.

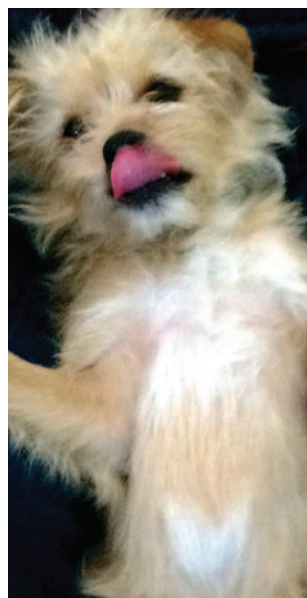


◀ **OLIVE YOU!**
